OCTOBER 2008 NEWSLETTER

OFFICER ELECTIONS: The quorum present at the Annual Meeting on October 13 re-elected all the current officers to their present positions for another year. There was no opposition. The Board is grateful to those who were present.

NEW MEMBERS: Please welcome Bruce Haley and Kenneth Steadman. As serving members of the armed forces, these gentlemen are not subject to the top maximum for membership, and we thank them for their service.

KBI POLICE TRAINING: The entire south half of the range will be reserved for the exclusive use of KBI for officer training for the period of Monday October 20 thru Friday October 24, from daylight to 4 PM each day. The north side will remain open and the south side will generally be accessible AFTER 4 PM daily, so impact on range availability including the shotgun program will be minimal. Your cooperation will be appreciated, especially if their training program runs slightly past 4 PM.

LOCK ON THE NORTH GATE: Members need to snap the club padlock thru the hasp of the KP&L padlock, instead of thru the chain only. Go "lock-to-lock" so to speak. KP&L needs access in order to read the power meter.

2009 PROGRAM SCHEDULES: XO Trey Owston requests that all program chairmen submit their 2009 schedules to him no later than the end of the 2nd week in January, so the 2009 schedule for range use can be prepared. Trey's phone number is 620-662-6231.

HPD RANGE USE: Their last scheduled exclusive use of the south half of the range will be from 12-3:30 PM on Thursday November 6th.

SHOTGUN SCHEDULE: The shotgun program will soon be switching over to their Winter schedule. Until the end of Daylight Savings time, the summer schedule will continue as follows: Trap and Skeet will shoot the 1st, 3rd & 5th Sundays 1 PM – 4 PM and every Tuesday and Thursday from 4 PM – 7 PM. 5-Stand will shoot the 3rd Sunday only from 1 PM – 4 PM. This will change to the Winter Schedule and coincide with Standard Time to provide Skeet only from 3 PM to 5 PM. Trap and 5-stand will not function during the Winter Schedule. They plan occasional "special" events on the 5th Sunday in lieu of regular. All scheduled shoots and events will be "weather permitting" and subject to cancel due to rain, snow or unsafe conditions like lightning or hail. SMALLBORE RIFLE SILHOUETTE: Their final match for 2008 is scheduled for October 26th, with registration starting at 7:30 AM. In general, you would shoot at chickens, pigs, turkeys and rams at ranges of 40, 60, 77 and 100 yards, from the standing position. Scope sights are allowed and very highly recommended, and there are some restrictions regarding weight of the rifle and such. Equipment generally consists of a 22-rifle, ammunition, eye and ear protection, and yourself, so nearly anyone can try it. Standard velocity ammo only, no hot loads.
