

The Sand Hill Regulators of the Central Kansas Gun Club in Hutchinson, Kansas will start its 2012 long-range cowboy match schedule in April. We're hoping y'all can come out and show us your skills with the long guns. Our first match will be April 14, 2012. Safety meeting at 8:30 with shooting starting at 9:00 pm. We will shoot the second Saturday of each month through October.

We will fire up the grill for lunch so bring some hot dogs or whatever you like. We will have the usual condiments.

We're hoping you'll come out and give it a try. You don't need to shoot all the matches below, just the ones you want to try or all of them if you want.

Courses of Fire:

Matches with period correct .22 lr, pistol caliber rifle, lever action big bore, single shot big bore and military bolt gun (lead bullets only). Each match is fifteen shots with two sighters at each distance with each rifle.

.22 lr and pistol caliber rifle – 100, 150 and 200 yards  
big bores and military bolt gun – 200, 300 and 400 yards

Scoring:

- 1 point for every hit at first target
- 3 points for every hit at second target

5 points for every hit at third target
